



ISIS 41 CLUB

CLUB RULES

1. NAME

The club shall be known as “THE ISIS 41 CLUB”

2. MEMBERSHIP

- a. Membership shall be opened to members or ex-members of RTBI who have attained the age of 40.
- b. Honorary Membership, which shall be subject to annual election, may be awarded at the Club’s discretion. Honorary Members may not hold office or have a vote.
- c. The Area Chairman, Immediate Past Chairman and Vice Chairman of RTBI Area 50 shall be invited to be an Honorary Member of the Club for his year of office.
- d. Members shall be elected into the club by invitation only.
- e. The newest member will be responsible for a raffle at each meeting but if unable to attend will nominate someone else for the task.

3. OBJECTS

See separate Isis 41 Club Objects.

4. OFFICERS

- a. The Officers shall consist of a Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer. All of these positions being Honorary.
- b. The day to day management of the Club shall be vested in the Club Committee, comprising of the Officers, two Committee Members and the Immediate Past Chairman.

- c. Of the two Committee Members one will be responsible for running the Club Programme, the other will be responsible for communication both internally and with RTBI Area 50 and Tangent. The Vice Chairman will be responsible for Membership and planning the following years programme
- d. The Officers and Committee Members shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting and take office at the conclusion of that Meeting.

5. CLUB YEAR

- a. The Club and Financial Year shall run from 1st.April to March 31st.
- b. The Annual General Meeting will take place during the last week of April.

6. ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION

- a. This shall be determined at the Annual General Meeting and become payable immediately.
- b. If any subscription should remain outstanding as at 31st December following the AGM, then the membership will be suspended, pending re-application, and payment of an application fee.

7. RULES

- a. No alteration, addition or deletion to these Rules shall be made except at an Extraordinary Meeting convened for that purpose or at the Annual General Meeting. Fourteen days notice of such alteration etc. shall be given by the Secretary in writing to all members. To be effective, such alterations etc., shall require the support of at least 67% of the members voting at the meeting. Requests for alterations to the rules must be given to the Secretary 28 days prior to the Annual General Meeting.
- b. The Club Committee shall be empowered to interpret these Rules and to make decisions on matters not covered by these Rules, subject to any such interpretation and decision being confirmed at the next succeeding Special or Annual General Meeting.

8. MEETINGS

- a. The Isis 41 Club will meet on the second Tuesday of each month, informally in August. Meetings and venues will be varied and will be organised by a member of the committee.
- b. The Club Committee will meet a minimum of four times a year. This will be in May (after the AGM), August, November and February.

- c. 10% of active members may request an Extraordinary General Meeting. Notice of this request and the reasons must be given in writing to the Secretary who will notify the membership accordingly.

These rules were adopted at the Inaugural General Meeting of the Isis Area 41 Club held on Wednesday 24th April 1994 at the Marlborough Hotel, Witney.

Rule 6a was added at The Annual General Meeting on Tuesday 29th April 1997.

Rule 2c, 2e, 4c and 8a was amended at The Annual General Meeting on Tuesday 30th April 2002.

The name of the Club was changed from The Isis Area 41 Club to The Isis 41 Club at the Annual General Meeting on Tuesday 26th April 2005.

Rules 4c and 8a were amended at the Annual General Meeting on Tuesday 18th April 2006
